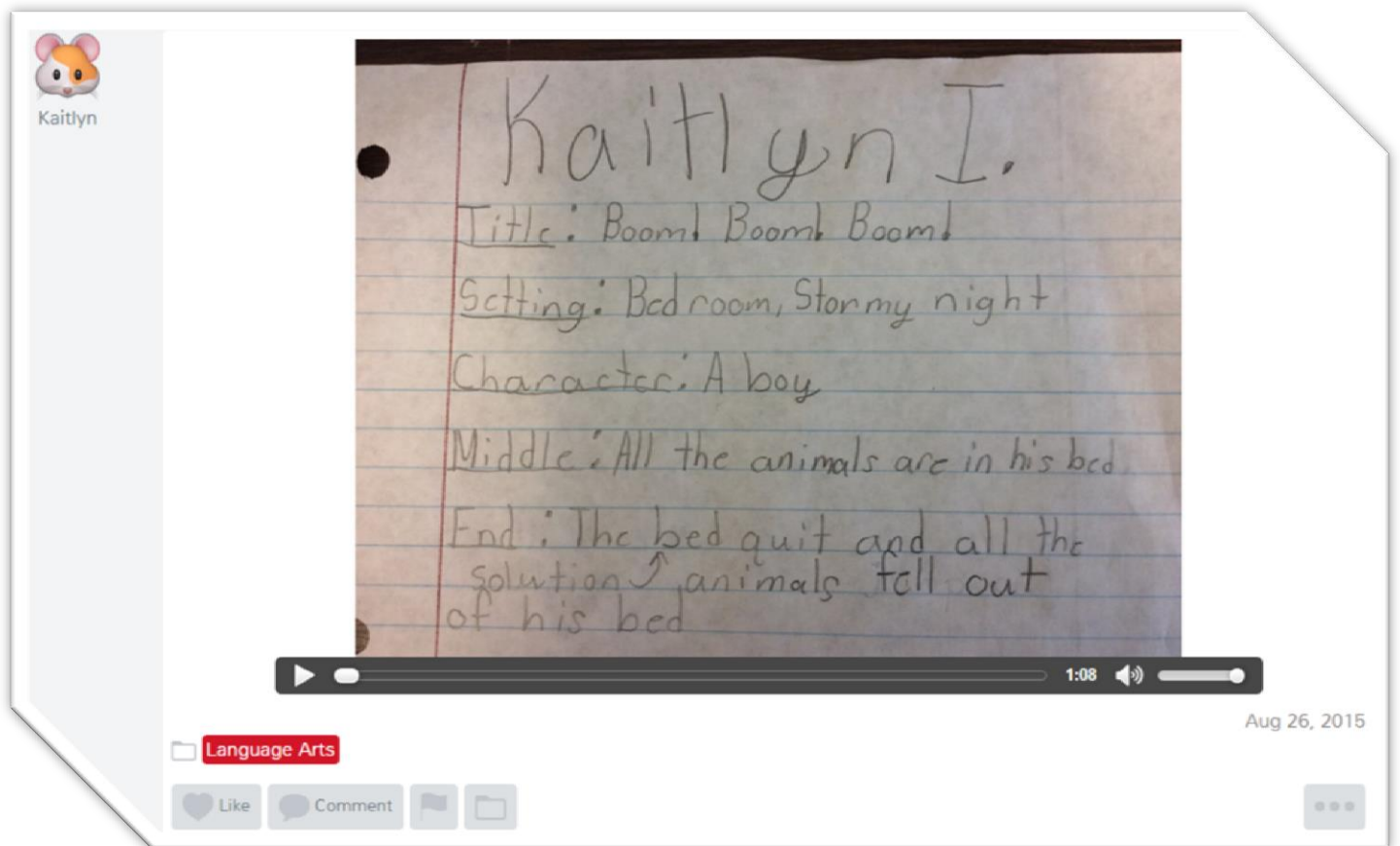
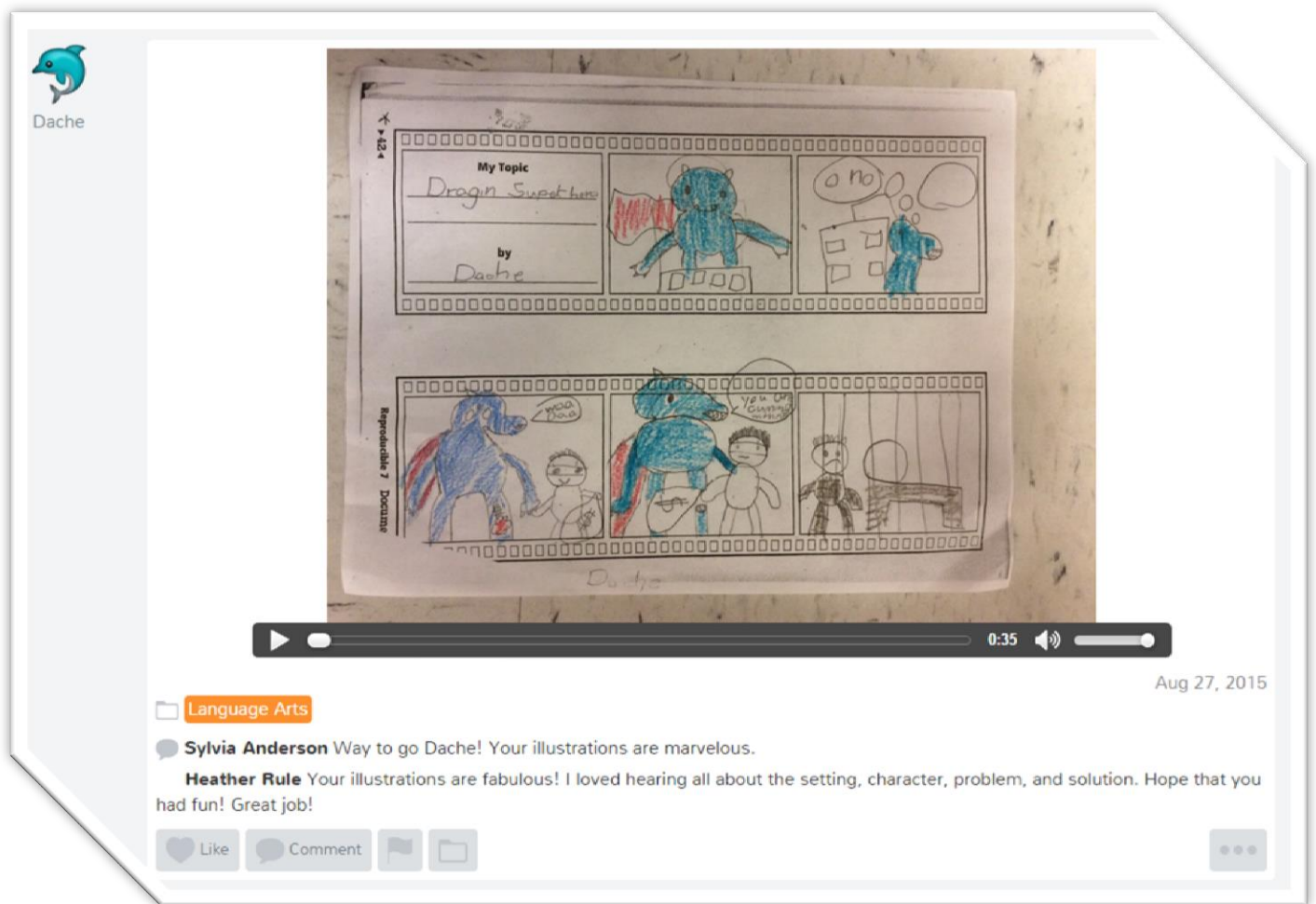

Her students received one-on-one assistance with Ms. Anderson to explain the app and how their journal will only be shared with the teacher and their parents. Their excitement level was off the chart. Once all students have one assignment entered a letter will go home to parents so that they may take part in their child's accomplishments by liking or commenting on their journal entries.



Students gain access to the program by scanning a special QR Code that is unique to their teacher's class therefore entries can only be made from school.

Mrs. Rule's Class began using SeeSaw on Thursday, August 27th. After being introduced to the **iPads**, her students learned to take a picture of their work and then add voice to it explaining the story elements in their comic strip. Seeing their smiles afterwards is going to make this year long project worth the effort. The kids are very excited about this digital journal being shared with only their teacher and parents.
